

INSTALLATION TECHNICIAN-1

POSITION OVERVIEW: Installer Technician-1 reports directly to the Project Managers on a daily activities basis. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, performing system installation, startup and closeout of all jobs, and other tasks as assigned by the Project Managers and Company staff.

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES:

- Installs and pulls wire, cable, and fiber optic and data cable as per project specifications.
- Installs and wires all equipment as used in systems including, but not limited to; wire and cable, plates, panels, floor boxes, video projectors and screens, low voltage control systems, data circuits and speaker systems.
- Tests all equipment after termination is made to confirm performance of system.
- Work in compliance with the Company's safety policies with safety of self and others in mind at all times.
- Daily communications with Project Manager on delays, requirements and general status of jobs.
- Timecards are accurate, filled out completely with job numbers each day, phase codes, time totaled, hours are correct, time card is signed and turned in at the end of last day that worked that week.
- Works with Project Manager to oversee the installation to ensure jobs are on track and within the estimate.
- Responsible for daily work assignments for Installation Technician-2 including, but not limited to Company policies and procedures, time cards, systems and installation techniques.
- All work is performed to Company standards and quality installation techniques are practiced.
- Work with Project Managers on startup to ensure complete system compliance.
- Works with Project Manager to ensure complete closeout and turn over of jobs to the client and service department.
