

INSTALLATION TECHNICIAN-APPRENTICE

POSITION OVERVIEW: Installer Technician-Apprentice reports directly to the Installation Technician-Foreman and Project Managers on a daily activities basis and other tasks as assigned by Company staff.

RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES:

- Responsible to Installation Foreman and PM as directed for daily work assignments.
- Installs and pulls wire as per specifications.
- Installs and wires all equipment as used in systems including, but not limited to; wire and cable, plates, panels, floor boxes, video projectors and screens, control systems, data circuits and speaker systems.
- Tests all wiring and equipment after termination is made to ensure performance of system.
- Work in compliance with the Company's safety manual with safety of self and others in mind at all times.
- Timecards are accurate, filled out daily with job numbers, codes, time adds up, hours are correct, time card is submitted on the end of last day of that week.
- All work is performed to Company standards and quality installation techniques are practiced.

QUALIFICATIONS:

General:

- Must be 18 years of age and have a valid Florida driver's license with a clean driving record. Offer of
 employment subject to review by Company's auto liability insurance carrier of applicant's driving record.
- Applicant recognizes the total commitment by Company to maintain a Drug Free Work Place (DFWP) and agrees to participate in any program as directed by Company in order to establish and maintain Drug Free Work Place (DFWP) certification.
- Must be committed to being punctual and reliable.

Knowledge:

- Related experience working in one of the following type trades or related (Electrician / Electrical, Low Voltage / Structure Wiring, IT / Data, Security Systems, Structural Rigging, General Construction)
- Proper hand and power tool operations for proficient and safe use
- Basic ability to read functional onelines and schematics
- Basic computer and iOS skills / operation.

Skills/Abilities:

- Ability to solve practical problems and carry out responsibilities under general supervision
- Ability to finish tasks
- Ability to organize workload for effective implementation
- Ability to function as an effective team member
- Must be able to see, hear, speak and write clearly in order to communicate with employees and/or other customers; light to moderate construction work requiring manual dexterity for reaching, climbing and lifting of heavy objects, and operating power tools and office equipment.
- Perform all duties as required on job sites where conditions are typical throughout various phases of commercial, public, sports, religious and educational building construction projects.
- Must insure that safety is priority #1 and comply with OSHA standards
- Must be able to see, hear, speak and write clearly in order to communicate with employees, other trades, general contractors and customers
- Must be able to carry out moderate construction type work requiring manual dexterity for reaching, climbing, including working from scaffolding and lifts. Lifting of heavy objects, and operating power tools.
